



## PER I TURISTI STRANIERI: GUIDARE IN ITALIA

### • MOPEDS

When riding in Italy, moped riders must have with them at all times:

- Moped registration document (or technical certificate).
- Valid national entitlement to drive a moped (if applicable).
- Third party liability insurance cover bought in an EU country.  
Residents of non-EU countries should contact their insurance company prior to departure and check whether they need a green card or a short term insurance.
- Road tax receipt (only for mopeds registered in Italy).

Moped riders cannot carry any passenger until they are 18 years old.

Moped riders aged at least 18 can carry one passenger, provided this is indicated in the moped registration document.

*FINE for non-compliance of age limit or of passenger transport restriction in the moped registration document (article 170, paragraph 6, Italian Highway Code): 80 to 323 Euros.*

*PENALTY POINTS on driving licence: -1 out of 20 full starting points.*

*In case the infringement is committed by a minor, the moped is impounded for 60 days.*

### HELMET

Motorcycle or moped riders must wear a helmet. Helmets must be European type-approved and must be worn correctly at all times.

*FINE for non-compliance (article 171, paragraph 2, Italian Highway Code): 80 to 323 Euros.*

*PENALTY POINTS on driving licence: -5 out of 20 full starting points.*
