

PER I TURISTI STRANIERI: GUIDARE IN ITALIA



MOPEDS

When riding in Italy, moped riders must have with them at all times:

- moped registration document (or technical certificate).
- [Valid national licence](#) entitling to drive a moped.
- Third party liability insurance bought in an EU country.
Residents of non-EU countries should contact their insurance company prior to departure and check whether the company can issue the third party liability insurance in Italy or they need a [green card](#) or a [short term insurance](#).
- Road tax receipt (only for mopeds registered in Italy).

Moped riders cannot carry any passenger until they are 16 years old.

Moped riders aged at least 16 can carry one passenger, provided this is indicated in the moped registration document.

It is unlawful to carry children under the age of 5 on a moped. FINE for non-compliance (article 170, paragraph 6-bis, Highway Code): 161 to 647 Euros.

FINE for non-compliance with age limit for transporting a passenger or with passenger transport restrictions according to the moped-registration document (article 170, paragraph 6, Italian Highway Code): 81 to 326 Euros.

PENALTY POINTS on driving licence: -1 out of 20 full starting points.

In case the infringement is committed by a person under the age of 16, the moped is impounded for 60 days.

HELMET

Motorcycle or moped riders must wear a helmet. [Helmets must be EU type-approved](#) and must be worn correctly at all times.

FINE for non-compliance (article 171, paragraph 2, Italian Highway Code): 81 to 326 Euros.

PENALTY POINTS on driving licence: -5 out of 20 full starting points.
