DRIVING IN ITALY: INFORMATION FOR VISITING MOTORISTS

BICYCLES

Cyclists must not carry anything hampering their arms and legs when riding. They must hold the handlebar with at least one hand. Cyclists must also wear a high visibility reflective vest or braces when riding outside built-up areas starting from half an hour after sunset until half an hour before sunrise. They must always wear a reflective jacket or braces when riding in tunnels, both in built-up areas and outside.

In case of non-compliance, the sanctions provided for in Article 182 paragraph 10 of the Italian Highway Code apply.

* High visibility reflective vests/braces must have specific technical features established by law. It is important to check that the garments bear the CE along with the international standard UNI EN 471 marks.
