DRIVING IN ITALY: INFORMATION FOR VISITING MOTORISTS

PEDESTRIANS

It is mandatory to stop and give way to pedestrians walking on a zebra crossing or waiting to cross.

If a pedestrian is about to cross at the zebra crossing or has already begun to cross a road with no pedestrian crossing, drivers must give way and therefore slow down or, if necessary, stop.

Special attention must be paid to the disabled, the elderly and children's predictable actions when they are crossing the road.

In case of non-compliance, the sanctions provided for in Article 191 paragraph 4 of the Italian Highway Code apply.
